### JEANNETTE PUBLIC LIBRARY RECEIVES GRANT FOR BUILDING ENERGY AUDIT

**Jeannette, PA** – The Jeannette Public Library (JPL) recently received a grant from the West Penn Power Sustainable Energy Fund (WPPSEF) to obtain an energy audit of their building. The audit is a first step towards the Library utilizing sustainable energy options. The JPL Board of Directors will use the results to develop a strategy for implementing any needed alterations. With the support of WPPSEF, the audit will be done by Envinity, Inc. of State College at the library building on Magee Ave in Jeannette.

“We are very thankful for this opportunity, and for the support of WPPSEF. This audit will enable us to take steps towards becoming more energy efficient. Reducing energy costs will help with our being able to continue to serve the community,” said Angela Betz, JPL Director.

Joel Morrison, WPPSEF Fund Administrator, stated: “Our funding of this activity will provide the library with a comprehensive plan to better understand their energy use within their facility and to prioritize actions to reduce their operating cost. This fits well with the mission of the WPPSEF to reinvest in local communities to help reduce energy usage through technology.”
